TO LIGHTING

- 1. Make sure the control knob is in the "OFF" position.
- 2. Open the door and slowly open the valve on the propane gas tank by turning the knob counterclockwise.
- Close the door on the body.
- 4. Push and hold in the electronic igniter to create sparks within the electrode, continue to hold.
- 5. Push in the control knob, and turn to the "LOW" position. Keep holding down the control knob, to allow gas to few for 45 seconds.
- 6. If ignition doesn't occur within a few seconds release the control knob, and rotate to the "OFF" position. Wait for 5 minutes for gas to clear and then repeat the above lighting instructions.
- 7. Once the fire product is lit, the flame intensity may be controlled by turning the control knob between the "LOW" and "HIGH" positions.

To Extinguish

- 1. Turn and push the control knob clockwise to the "OFF"position.
- 2. Turn the cylinder valve on the gas tank to clockwise to close.
